


SILVIUS LEOPOLD WEISS

A reconstruction by **Jeffrey Cohan** (baroque one-keyed flute) and **Oleg Timofeyev** (baroque lute) of the early 18th-century sonatas for obbligato baroque lute and the baroque one-keyed flute by Sylvius Leopold Weiss, the most famous lutenist of the 18th century, for which only an incomplete manuscript remains.
